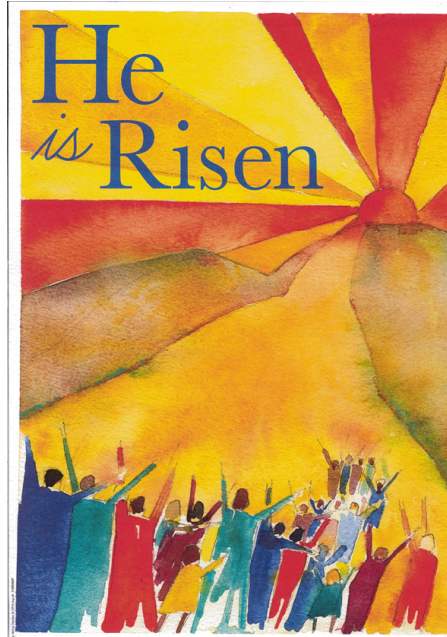


HCMC Information sheet – 20th April 2025
